

Braunton Academy

Pupil Premium, Service Children and Catch Up Premium allocation

In 2015/16, 98 pupils at the Academy were eligible for the Pupil Premium. In addition, 48 pupils were eligible for the Service Children Premium

The current allocation is £935 per pupil for Pupil Premium and £300 per pupil for Service Children Premium. In addition, the Academy received £6,000 Catch Up Premium, which is £500 for each pupil in year 7 who did not achieve at least level 4 in reading or Maths at the end of KS2.

The Academy received a total of £113,255 in 2016/16, based on the number of Pupil and Service Premium students in the Academy in January 2015, the previous academic year.
