Dear Parent/Carer

Your child has been selected to take part in the trip to Uganda in July 2024 in conjunction with the local charity Amigos.

I would like to outline a few more details which are important for you to know and to enable them to decide if the trip to Uganda in July 2024 is one they still want to be involved in!

To take part in this experience each participating student needs to raise £2200. The breakdown of this £2200 is as approximately as follows:

 Flights (can increase/decrease) 	£850
 Accommodation/Food 	£490
 Transport 	£140
 Trips/Excursions 	£170
 Other (Water/materials for village work/visa/costs) 	£350
 Donation to Amigos 	£200
TOTAL	£2200

Braunton School policy states for all trips students must have paid all monies due for a trip prior to departure. Therefore, due to this policy we need to ensure that each child has plans to raise the £2200 which will need to be paid into school via Parentmail. Obviously as long as the money is paid into the Parentmail account set up for your child then we assume this was raised by them.

With this in mind we have set up the following payment deadlines which will mean the total of £2200 will be paid by June 15th 2024,

- 15th April 2023 £100 deposit
- 15th May 2023- £150 1st payment
- £150 on each subsequent month on 15th until June
- Your child will need inoculations to travel to Uganda and we will invite you to a parents' evening with representatives from Amigos where we will guide you on requirements. In previous years the cost of essential vaccinations has been less than £100. You will be responsible for funding these.

It also is required that all students have at least six months remaining on their passport when they travel to Uganda. Therefore, please ensure that your child's passport runs until at least February 2025. If this is not the case you will need to ensure renewal of passport at your own cost.

It is important that I know by this date if they still want to be considered as if not I will need to offer their place to someone on the reserve list.
