We will be holding several open events throughout Year 11, and these events are a great opportunity to learn what Exeter College has to offer. All courses will be represented at these open events, dates as follows, and students will be able to visit our city centre buildings as well as our Construction Centre at Sowton and Technology Centre at Monkerton. We hold interviews on a monthly basis from November onwards, therefore we recommend that students submit their application to college by around December/January which should allow plenty of time to attend an open event and research options before deciding on a course choice. Applying and attending an interview earlier in the academic year will allow students to focus fully on their revision and exams. Students can apply online through the Exeter College website or obtain a paper copy of the application form from school.

Later in the year, between GCSE results day and the start of September, students will be required to attend the college again for their enrolment appointment. This is when they confirm their place on their chosen college courses, or discuss alternative options if required.
