Access arrangements for post 16 academic, technical, vocational and apprenticeship providers

Braunton Academy use the Gatsby 8 Benchmarks to inform the provision of Careers Education, Information and Guidance (CEIAG) delivered.

As part of our commitment to informing students of the full range of learning and training routes available we consider requests from post 16 colleges and sixth forms, training providers, vocational education routes and apprenticeship providers to speak to students and will also approach these partners ourselves when planning and organising key CEIAG events throughout the school year.

All requests should be emailed at least 6 weeks in advance of an expected date for the planned session. All requests will be given due consideration from the designated Careers Leader and Senior Leadership.

Requests will be refused if:

- 12 they impinge on students preparation for public or internal exams
- they clash with other planned school events
- 12 the school is unable to provide staff to support the event
- Prooming is unable to be found due to timetabling clashes
